



Food Waste Recycling/Composting

Food waste is collected daily by the Village Crew, the waste is emptied into our Closed Loop Organics machine and after 24 hours your food waste comes out as compost, which can be used outside Kosciuszko National Park.

Compostable liners conforming to AS4736 must be used for organics bins/caddies so that they break-down in our Closed Loop machine. BioBags® can be accessed through Thredbo's Environmental Services department.



What you CAN and CAN NOT put in your Food Organics bin:

CAN

- ✓ Scraps from Food Prep
- ✓ Egg Shells
- ✓ Coffee Grounds & Tea Leaves
- ✓ Raw & Cooked Meat & Fish
- ✓ Small Bones e.g. Chicken or Fish Bones
- ✓ Cooked Foods
- ✓ Paper Napkins

CAN NOT

- ✗ Large Bones e.g. Ribs or T-bone
- ✗ Oyster, Scallop, Mussel or Clam Shells
- ✗ Tea Bags
- ✗ Cooking Oil *
- ✗ Metal, Plastic or Bio-degradable Cutlery
- ✗ Bio-degradable Cups/Plates
- ✗ Plastic or Packaging

*Cooking Oil is recycled through a separate collection process. Please refill empty cooking oil containers with old oil and add to your recycling enclosure.
